Come Together

- · Hold an informal transition meeting 6 or more weeks before the IEP annual review
- Repeat this meeting every year from high school through transition

Create the Vision

- How will THE STUDENT spend their day after they exit?
- What do THEY enjoy doing at school now that can be continued after they exit?
- Is the student INTERESTED in working, volunteering, taking classes, or recreational programming?
- Where will they live? What will they be responsible for? How will they get places?

Identify the Top Goals in the Vision

- Who
- What
- Where
- When
- Why
- How

Connect the Goals to Benefits

- · Students and families will be more motivated in pursuing these top goals when they have support
- Benefits can be funding sources, experts who can answer questions, reduced fares, special assistance, etc
- IDEA (entitled) turns in to ADA (eligible) and students and families will need guidance in how to seek out their own benefits, services, and supports
